


Questions to Ask Your Loved One's Doctor

about their prostate cancer treatment

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Your loved one's doctor and healthcare team are the best source of information about their treatment. It can be tough to remember all the questions you and your loved one want to ask during appointments. Use the list of questions below to start a conversation about treatment or help you both learn what to expect.



Starting on Treatment

- Is this treatment right for my loved one's stage and/or type of prostate cancer?
- How will it be determined if this treatment is right for my loved one?
- How will this treatment fit in with my loved one's current treatment plan for prostate cancer?
- Who should not take this treatment?

What to Expect on Treatment

- How is this treatment dosed?
- How often does my loved one have to take this treatment?
- What should my loved one do if they miss a dose?
- What are the potential side effects of this treatment, and are there things that can help us manage side effects?
- Are there medications or other things my loved one should avoid while taking this treatment?
- How will we know if this treatment is working?

Living with Prostate Cancer

- Are there additional tests my loved one will need throughout treatment (blood monitoring, lipids, etc.)?
- Are there activities or tips that can help my loved one stay healthy and cope while receiving prostate cancer treatment?
- What support and educational resources are available to assist me and my loved one during treatment?
